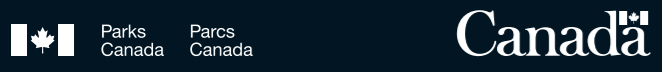

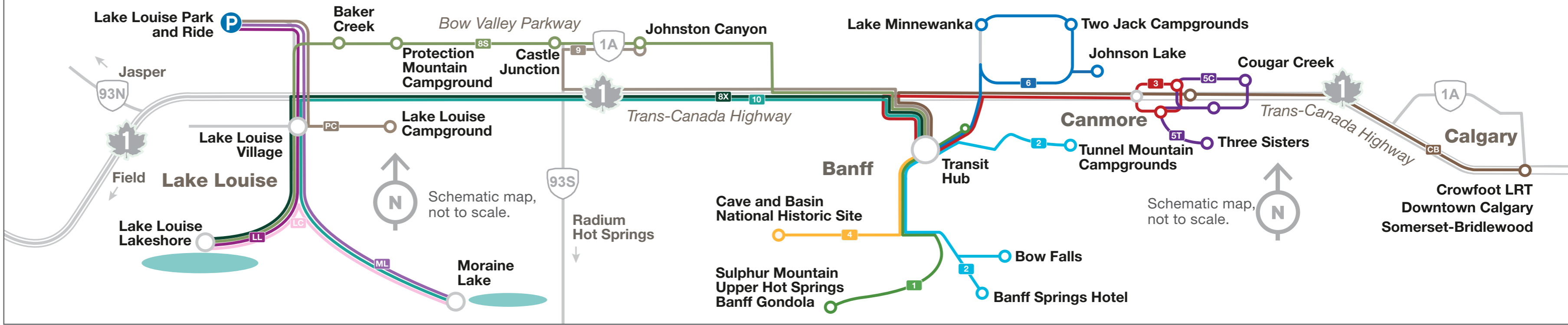

Reserve your ride on a Parks Canada shuttle

Due to high demand, visiting Lake Louise and Moraine Lake requires planning. Booking a Parks Canada shuttle is easy, stress-free and the only way to ensure you see these iconic lakes. **Booking your shuttle in advance is required.** Visit parks.canada.ca/lakelouise-transit for more information.

Start your day at the Lake Louise Park and Ride loading area, and be sure to arrive within your 1-hour reservation window. Conveniently visit both Lake Louise and Moraine Lake in the same day with one ticket.

² The Lake Connector shuttle is only available to Parks Canada shuttle reservation holders and Roam Reservable Super Pass or System Wide Day Pass (non-reservable) holders. Seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Return shuttle service from either lake back to the Park and Ride is included.

³ Travel on any Roam Public Transit routes from Canmore to Banff to Lake Louise and on Parks Canada Lake Connector Shuttle with a 1 Day Reservable Super Pass or System Wide Day Pass (non-reservable).

The Reservable Super Pass is sold via Roam's online reservation system. The System Wide Day Pass can be purchased as a walk-up passenger on the Roam bus, Roam ticket vending machines, through the Token Transit app or at the Roam customer service desk in the Banff Visitor Centre.

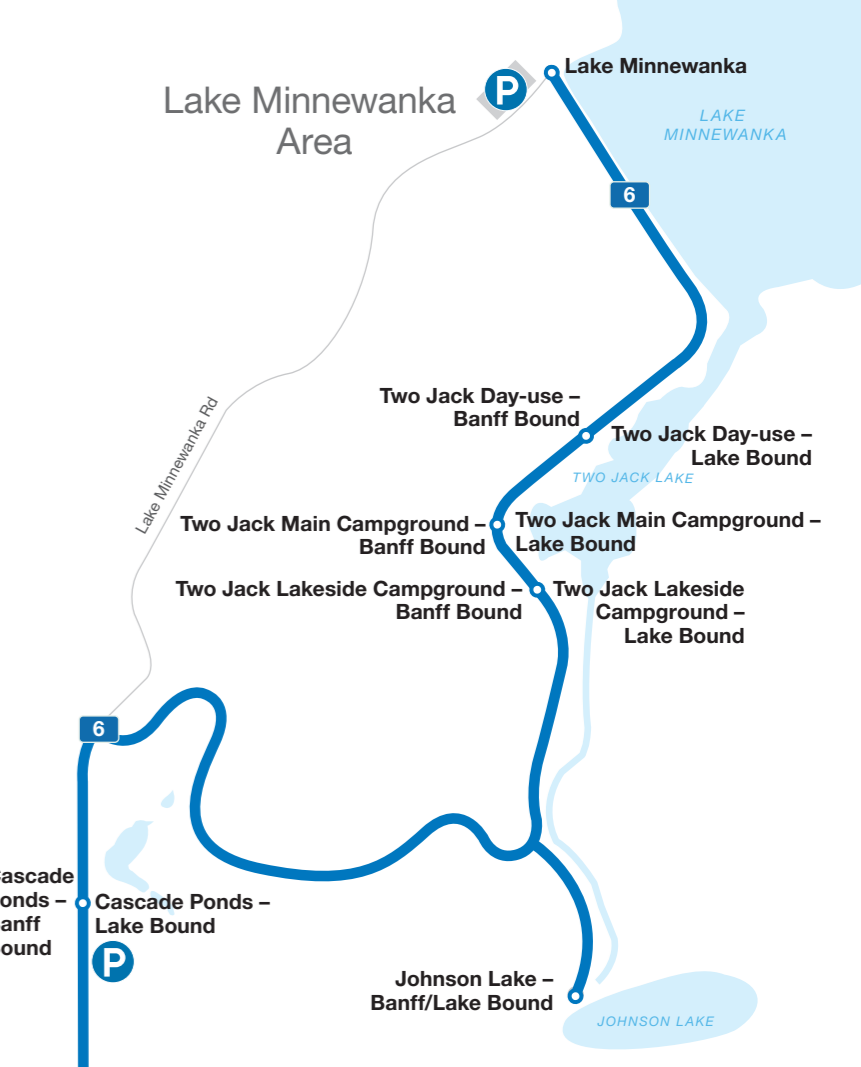
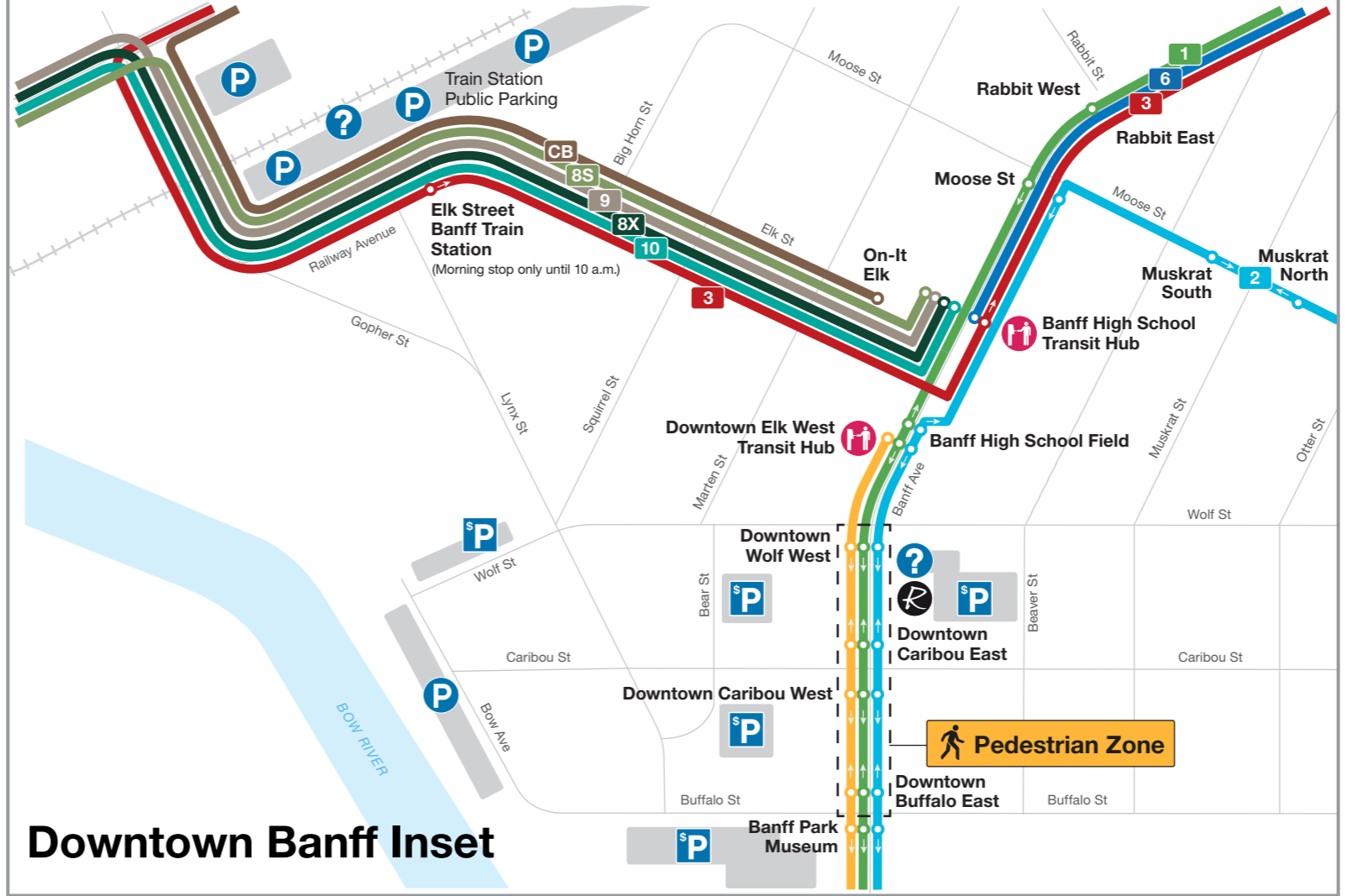
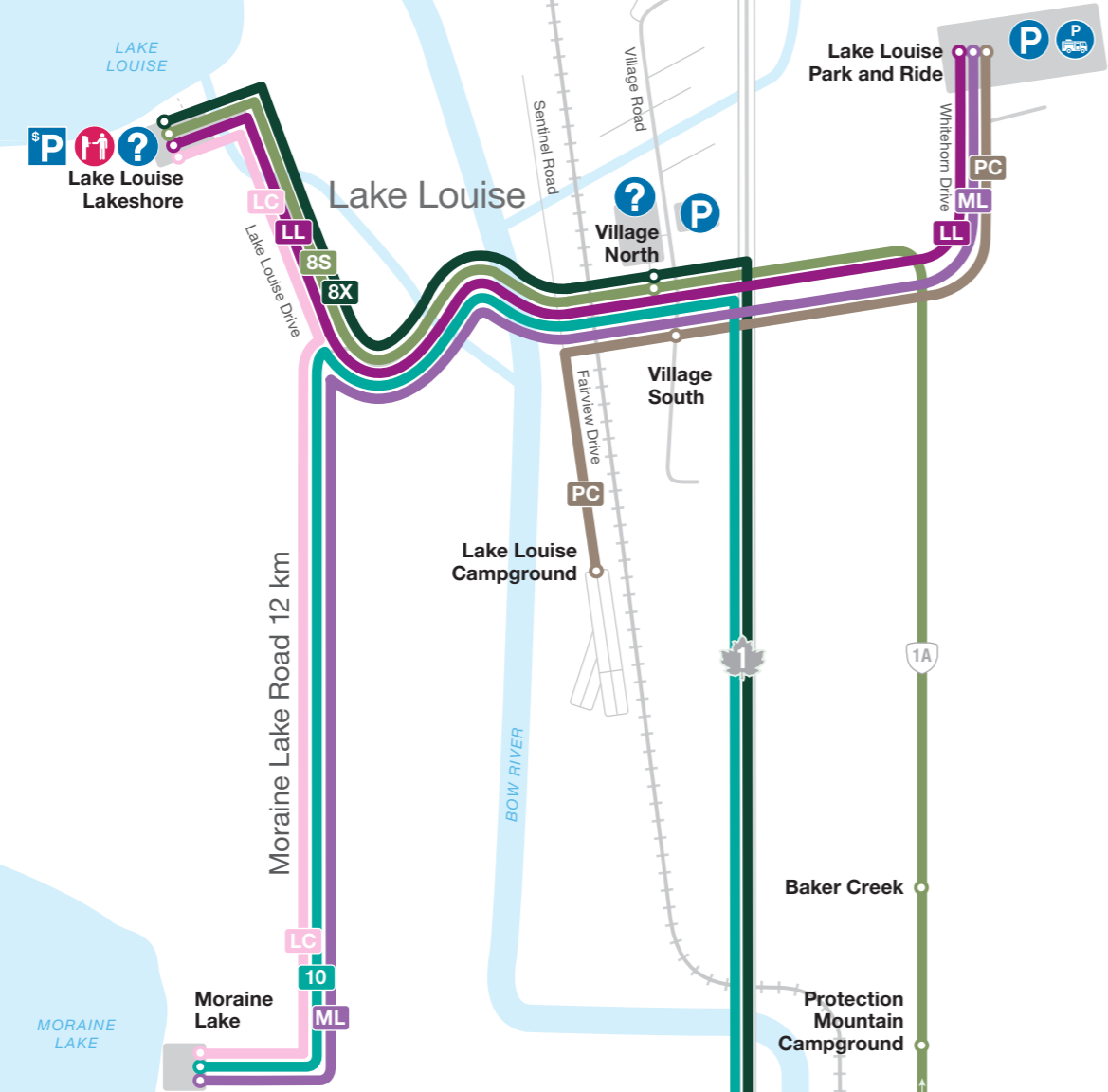

New in 2023 – Moraine Lake Road is closed to personal vehicles.

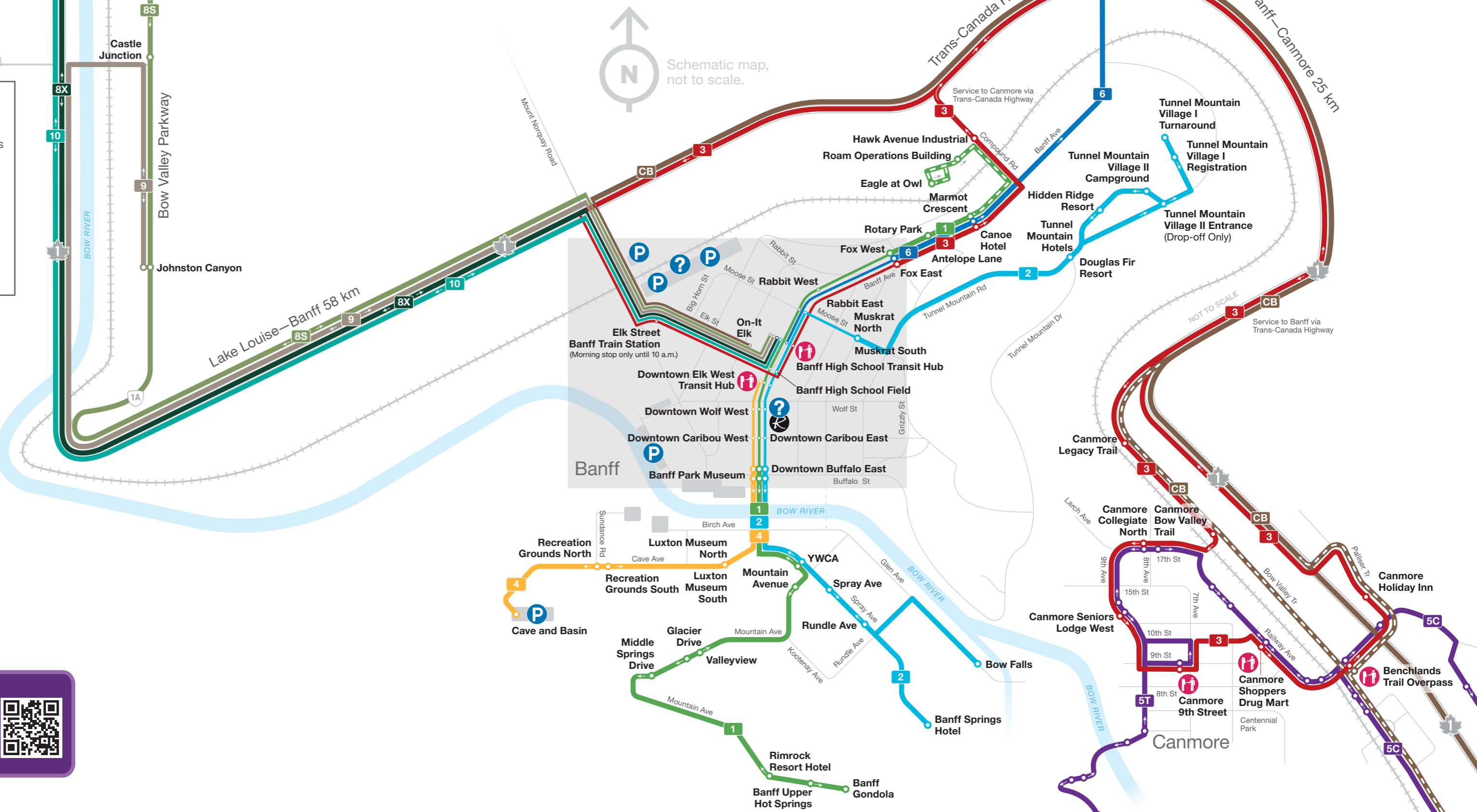
Moraine Lake Road is closed to personal vehicles year round. Parks Canada shuttles, Roam Public Transit and commercial buses are permitted from June to mid-October. Exceptions will be made for visitors with valid parking placards for people with disabilities and guests of Moraine Lake Lodge.

Reservations are required to ride Parks Canada shuttles to Lake Louise and Moraine Lake.

Fare includes use of the Lake Connector shuttle between the lakes as well as return trip from either lake back to the Park and Ride. Fare does not include reservation fee. Visit reservation.pc.gc.ca to book your spot and for more information.
