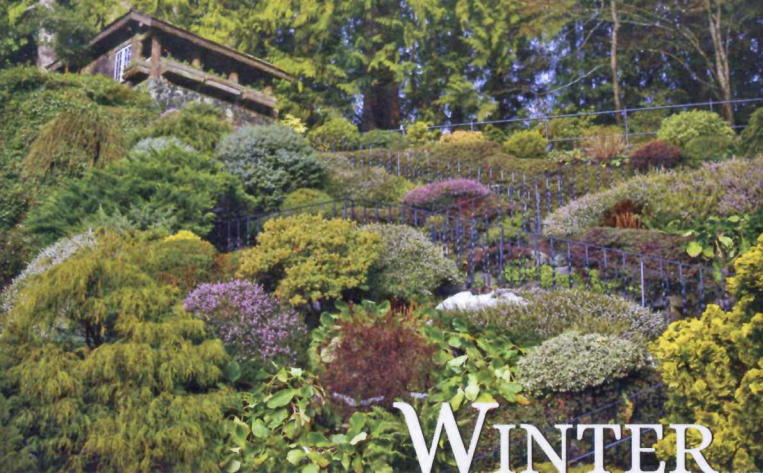

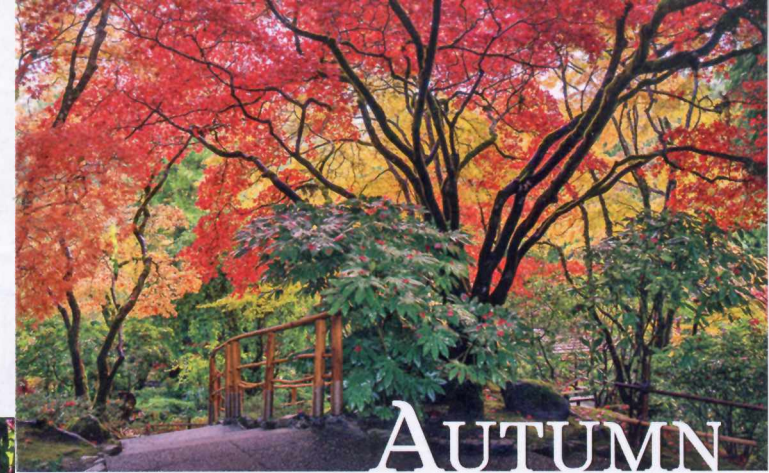
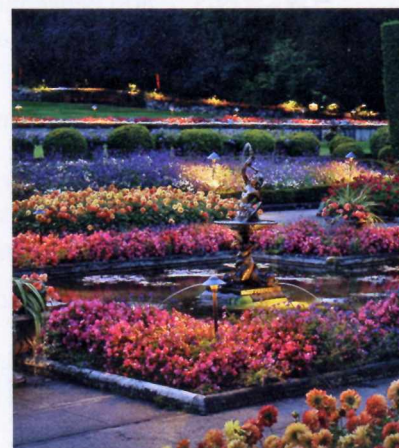
SUMMER
