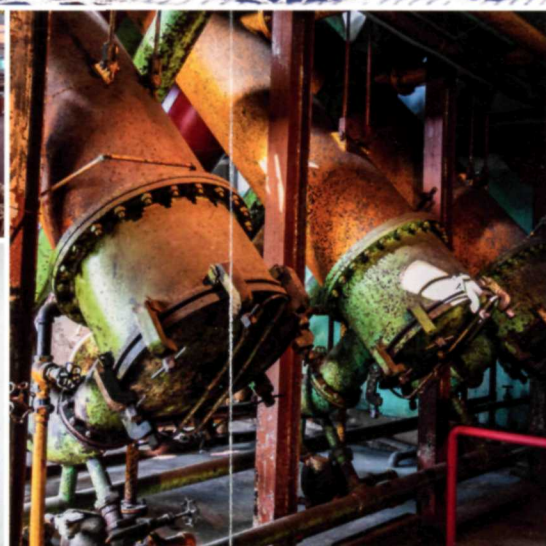
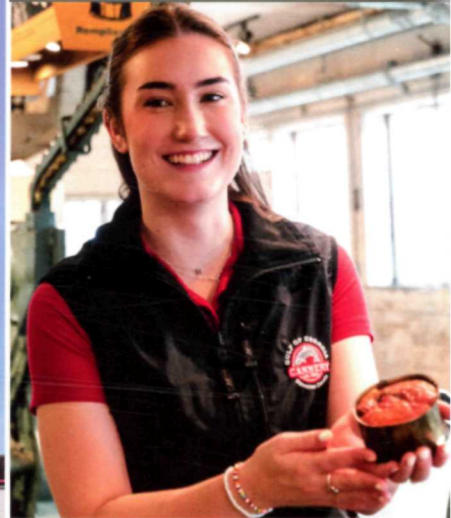
Canada's West Coast Fishing History

Built in 1894, the Cannery was the largest building of its kind and the leading producer of canned salmon in BC.
