## Over 250 years of history. One amazing town!

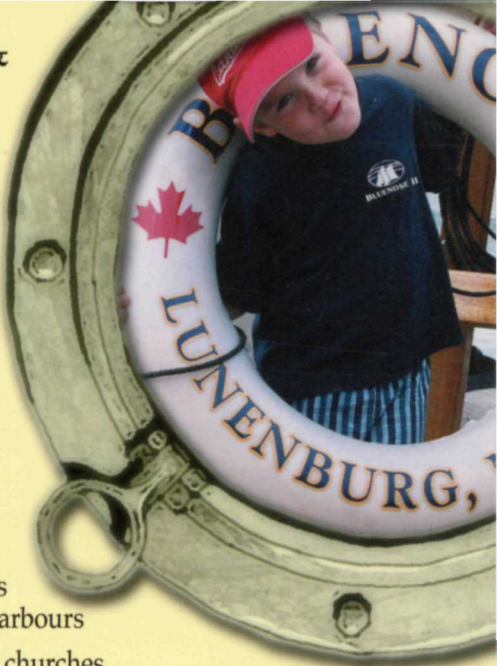
In 1995 UNESCO told the world what we've known for over 250 years – Lunenburg is exceptional – and named the town a World Heritage Site.
