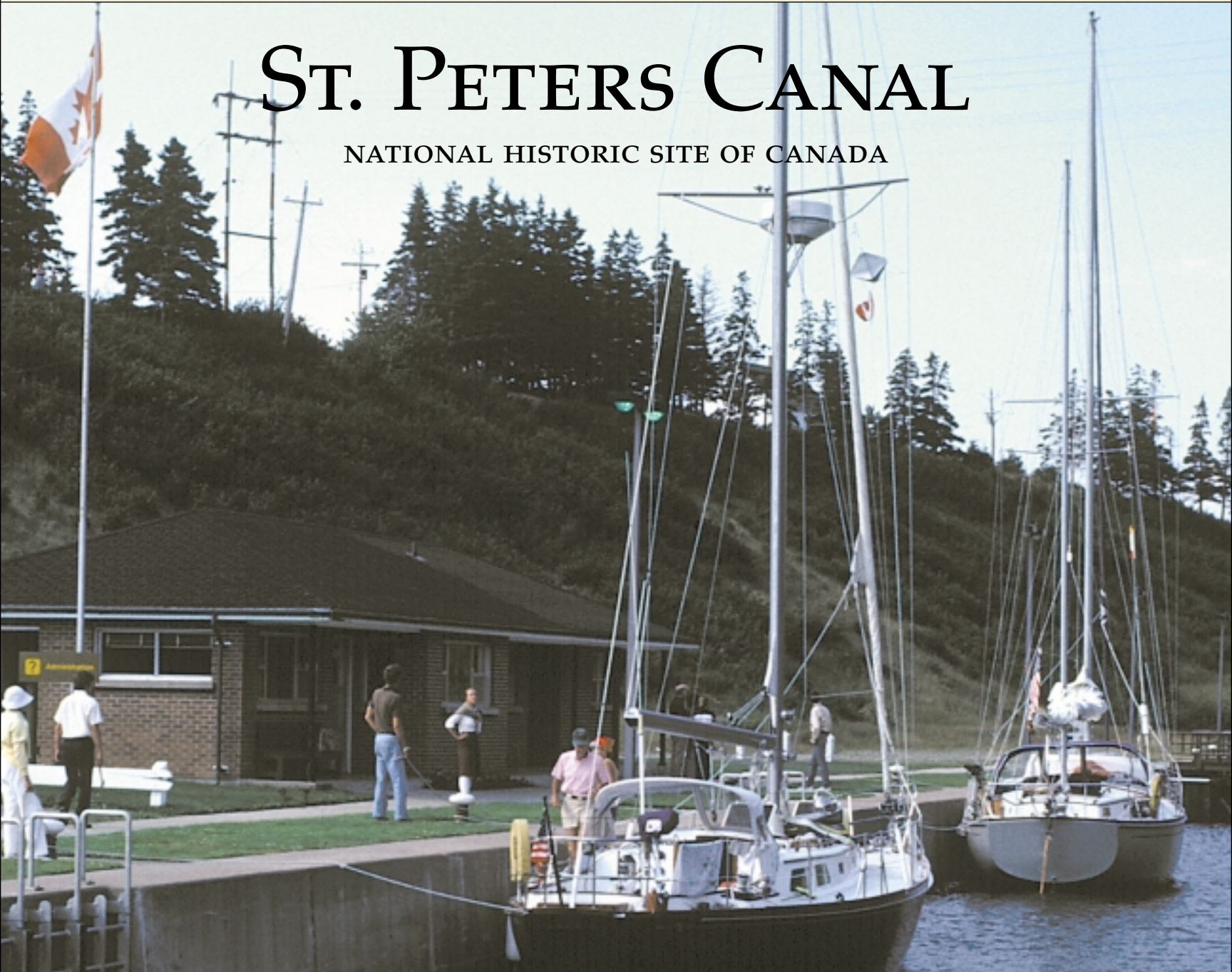


# ST. PETERS CANAL
