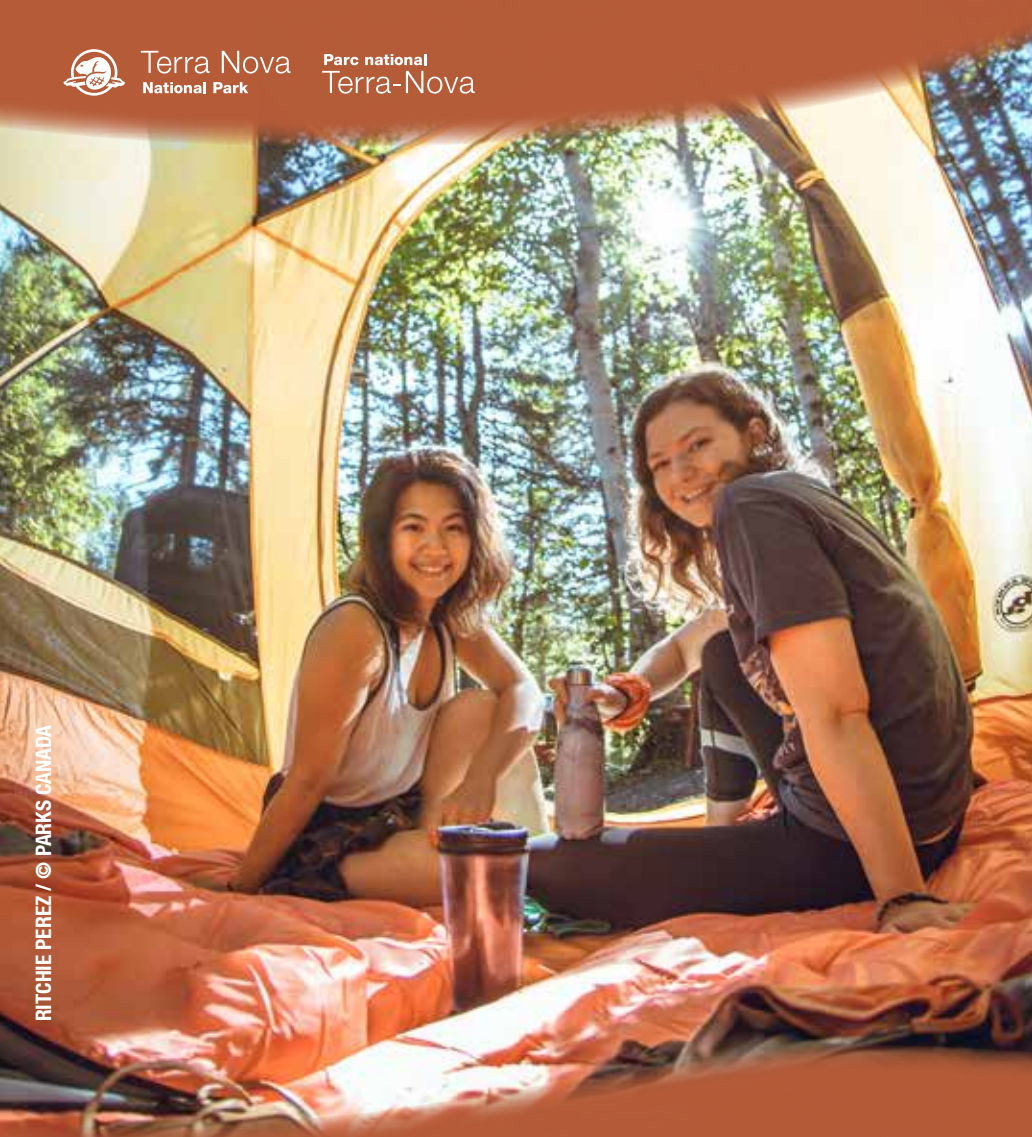

People like to camp at Terra Nova National Park. There are two campgrounds in the park. One campground is called Malady Head Campground. My family and I may go camping at Malady Head Campground.



The other campground, at Terra Nova National Park, is called Newman Sound Campground. My family and I may go camping at Newman Sound Campground.



Each campground has campsites. A campsite is a place outdoors used to stay overnight. Each campsite has a number on its post so we know where we are staying.



Some people like to bring tents to the park. Some people like to bring recreational vehicles, or RVs, to the park. A recreational vehicle is a large motor vehicle or trailer, used for travel and camping.

Other people like to stay in the oTENTiks or Ôasis that are in the park. All of these people will need campsites. My family and I can decide what we would like to stay in when we go camping.



Each campsite has a place to park a vehicle and a space for a tent or a recreational vehicle (RV). Each campsite also has a picnic table so we can eat outside.

We can also eat at a kitchen shelter. Some people call a kitchen shelter a picnic shelter or a cookhouse. When I go to the kitchen shelter I make sure I have my grownup with me so I don't get lost.



Sometimes we might hear other people, birds, or squirrels. We might hear the wind. That's okay.

There are washrooms at the campgrounds. I can brush my teeth, use the toilet and wash my hands in the washrooms. I can also use a shower in the washrooms. When I go to the washrooms I make sure I have my grownup with me so I don't get lost.



Camping in the park can be fun!
Sometimes the weather will be sunny and warm. Sometimes the weather will be rainy and cool.

We may see birds, squirrels, or other wild animals. We will see many different plants and trees.



We may go on a hike. When I leave the campsite to go on a hike, I make sure I have my grownup with me so I don't get lost.

We may visit a playground. When I leave the campsite to go to the playground, I make sure I have my grownup with me so I don't get lost.



If I need help or I am lost, I can ask people who work at Parks Canada for help.
