Bankhead Guided Walk

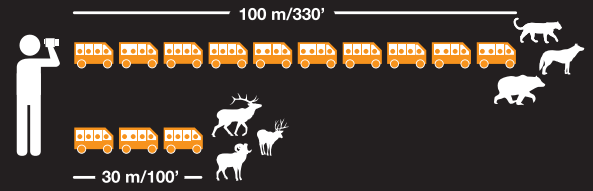
