Minnewanka Park & Ride—Lake Minnewanka: Parks Canada Shuttle

Service between Minnewanka Park & Ride and Lake Minnewanka.

Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and statutory holidays
June 23 – September 10, from 10:15 – 18:15.
Direct service leaving Minnewanka Park & Ride at 25 and 55 past the hour, and leaving Lake Minnewanka Day-use Area at 10 and 40 past the hour.

Lake Louise Area

Banff—Lake Louise: Parks Canada Shuttle

Service between the Banff Train Station and Samson Mall in the Hamlet of Lake Louise. Connects with shuttles to upper Lake Louise (May 19 - Sept. 10) and to Moraine Lake (Sept. 11 - Oct. 9).



Daily May 19 – October 9. Departs on the hour from Banff Train Station 07:00 -17:00. Departs on the hour from Samson Mall in the Hamlet of Lake Louise 08:00 – 18:00.

Lake Louise Seasonal: Parks Canada Shuttle

Service between Lake Louise Overflow parking, the Hamlet of Lake Louise and upper Lake Louise in the summer or Moraine Lake in the fall for larch season.



Upper Lake Louise: Daily from May 19 to September 10, 08:00 – 18:00.

Moraine Lake: Daily from September 11 to October 9, 08:00 – 18:00.

Shuttles depart every 15 minutes from the Lake Louise Overflow parking lot and travel to the Hamlet of Lake Louise and upper Lake Louise (May-Sept) and Moraine Lake (Sept-Oct).

Minnewanka Park & Ride

- Open 0800 – 2200 daily.
- Gates are locked 2200 – 0800 nightly.
- Camping, including sleeping in vehicles, is prohibited.
- No fires.

Travelling with Pets

- Assistance animals with certification are allowed on all public transit.
- Pets may only be transported on Roam buses in a closed crate or pet carrier that fits on the accompanying passenger's lap.
- Pets are not permitted on other services (*On-It Regional Transit* and *Parks Canada Shuttles*).

Travelling with Bicycles

- Up to 3 bicycles at a time may be transported on Roam buses equipped with exterior bike racks.
- Banff-Canmore regional Roam buses with interior and exterior racks can take up to 6 bikes.
- Once Roam bus racks are full, passengers with bicycles will have to wait for the next available bus with space.
- Other services (*On-It Regional Transit* and *Parks Canada Shuttles*) cannot accommodate bicycles.

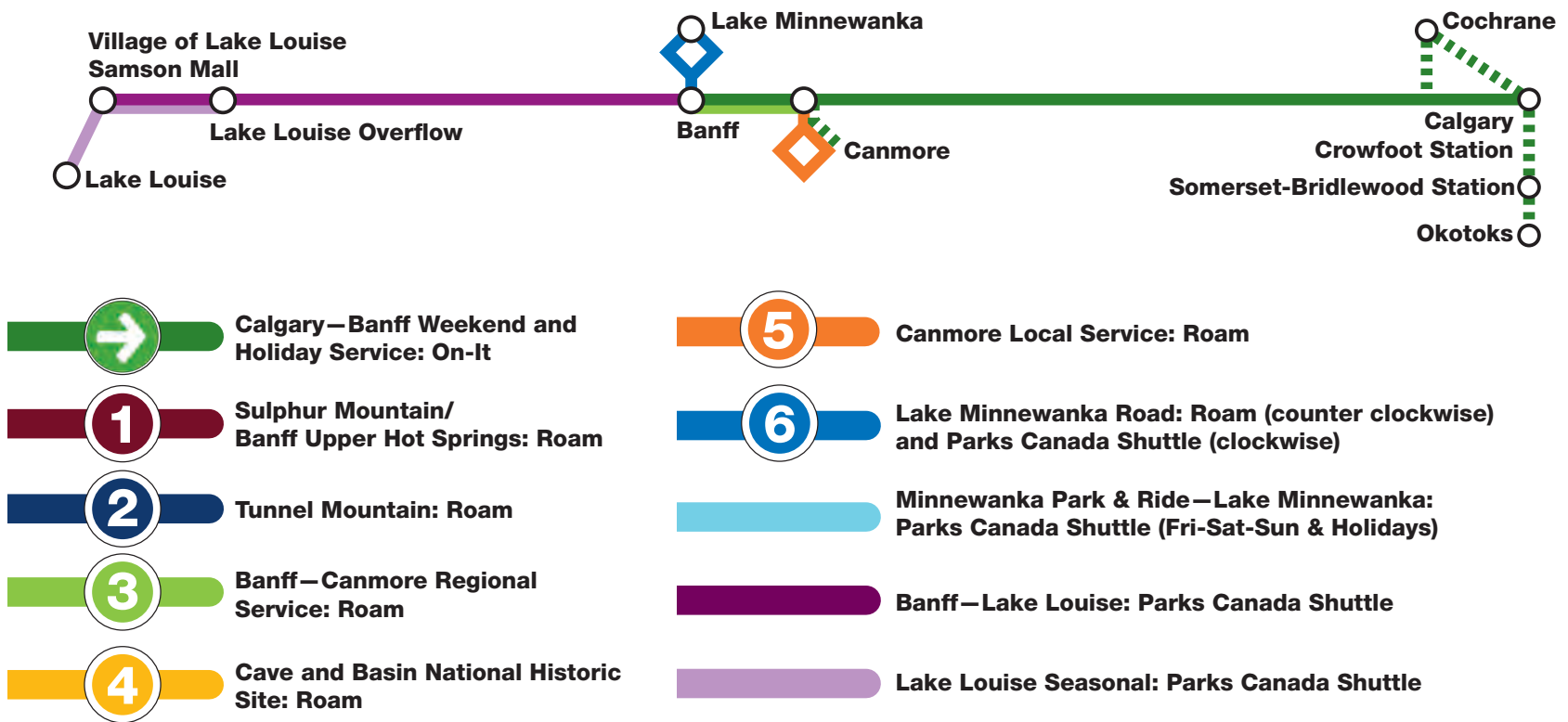
Public Transit Banff National Park



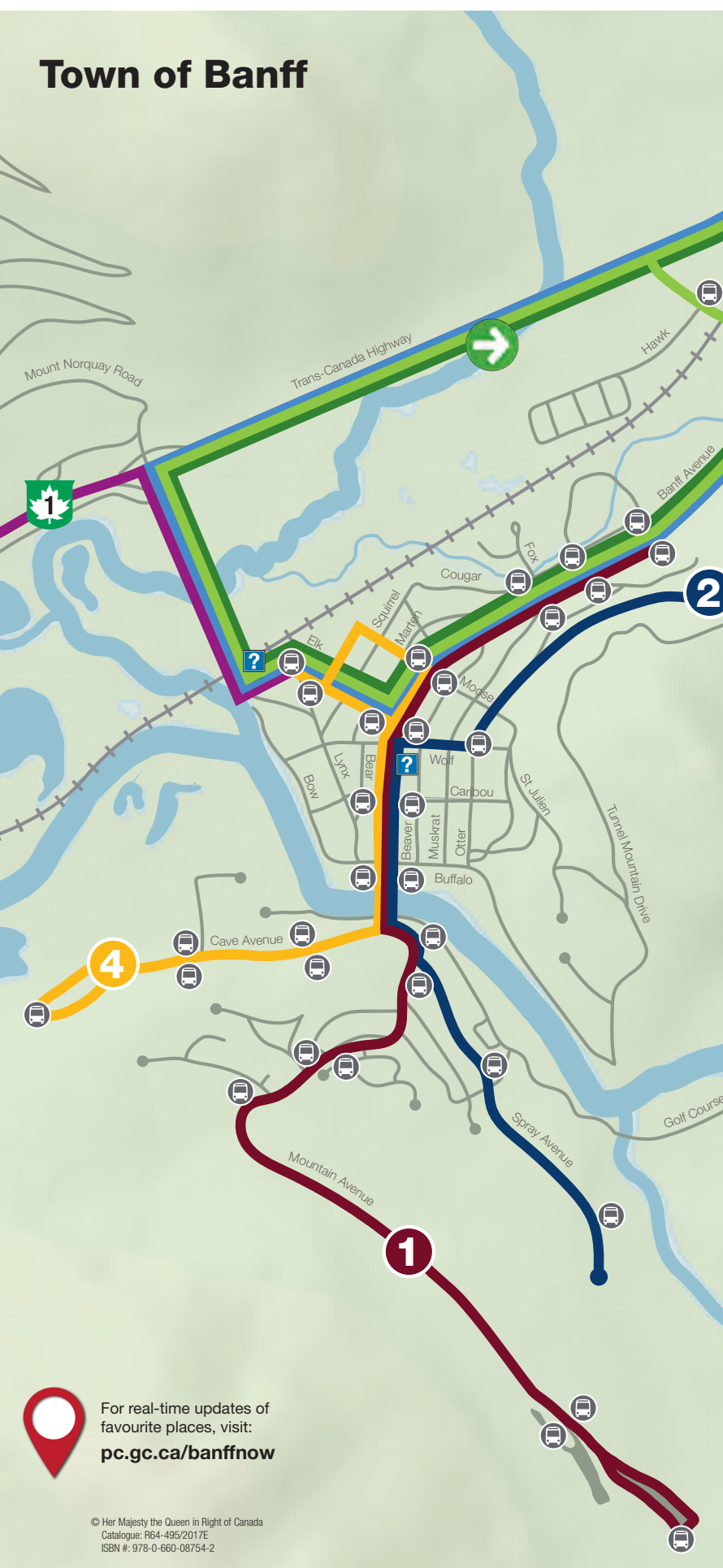
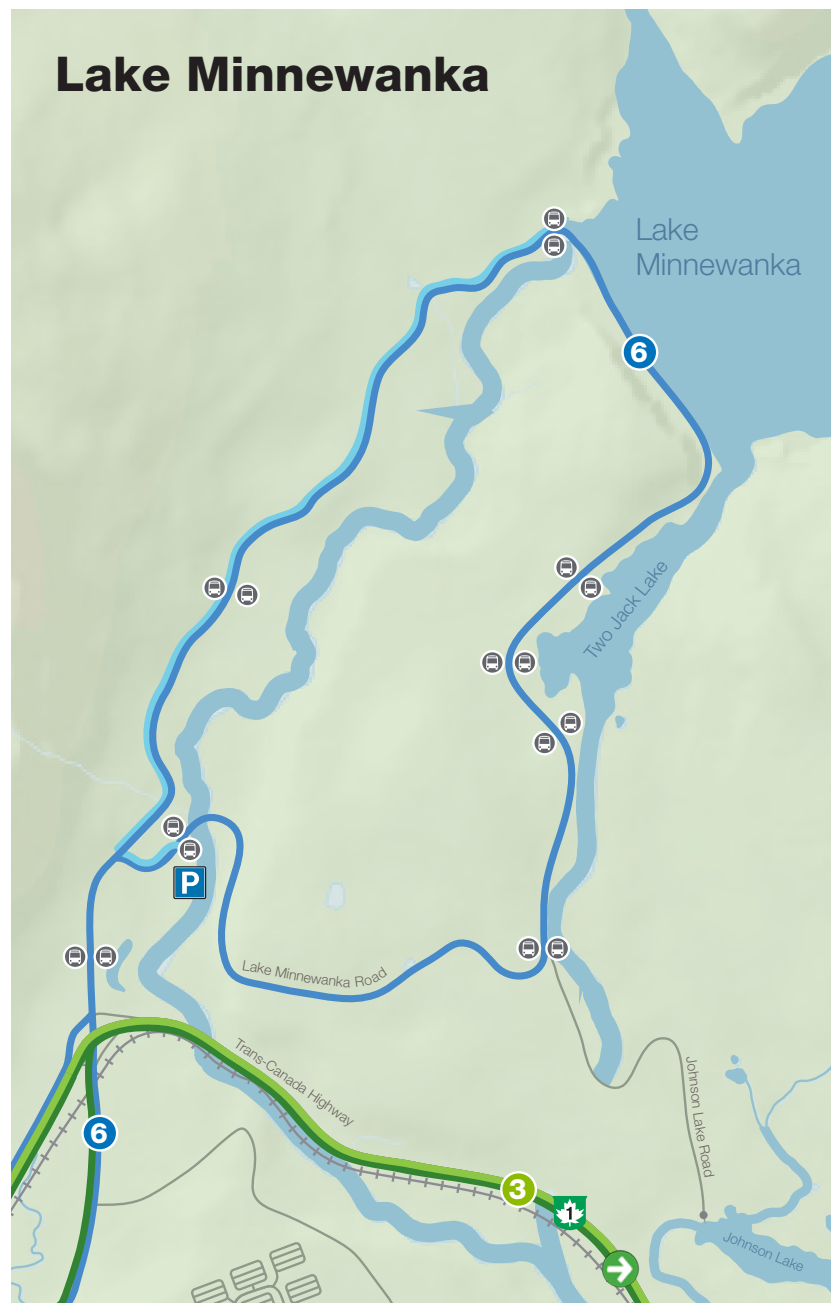
