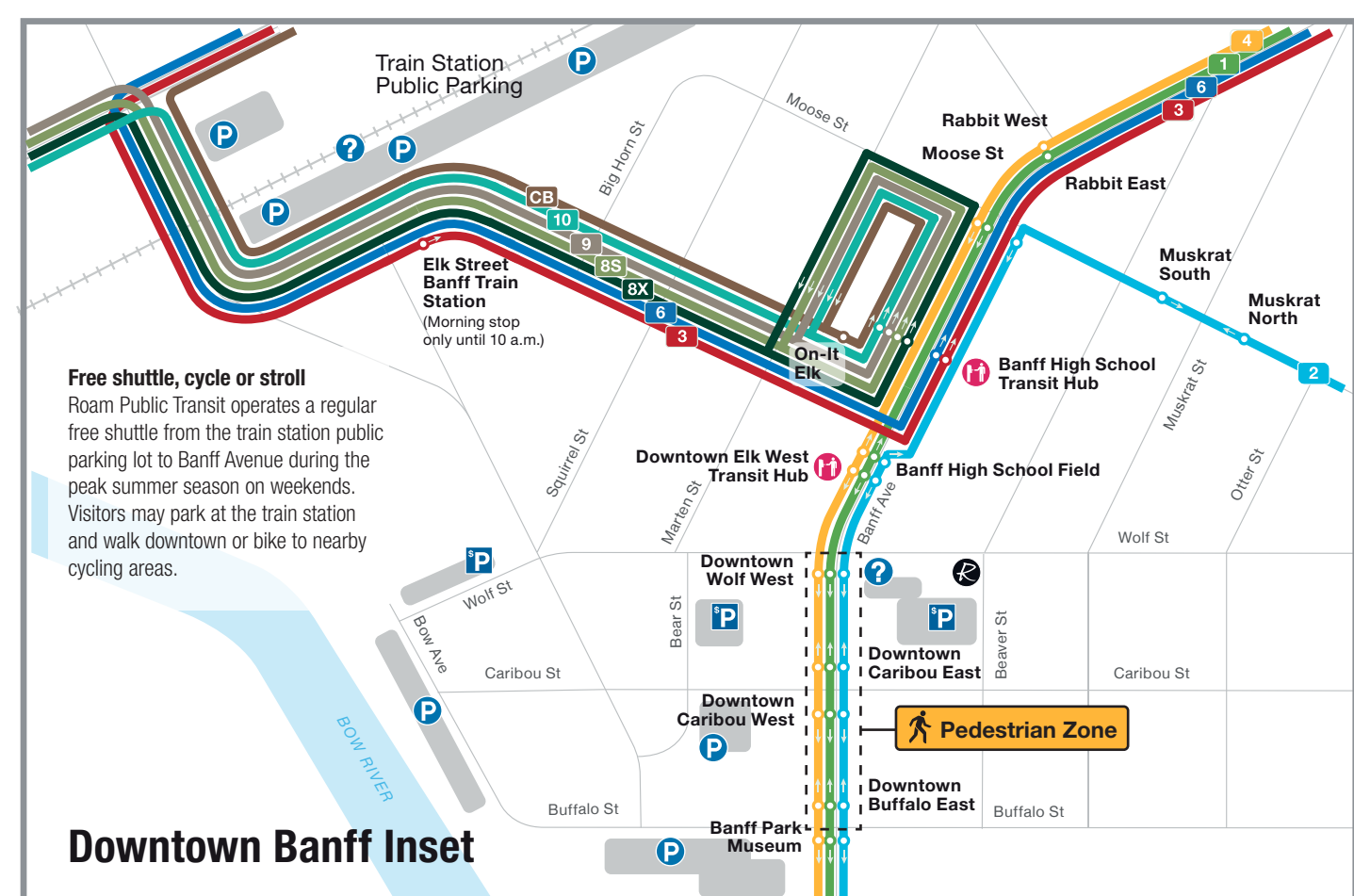
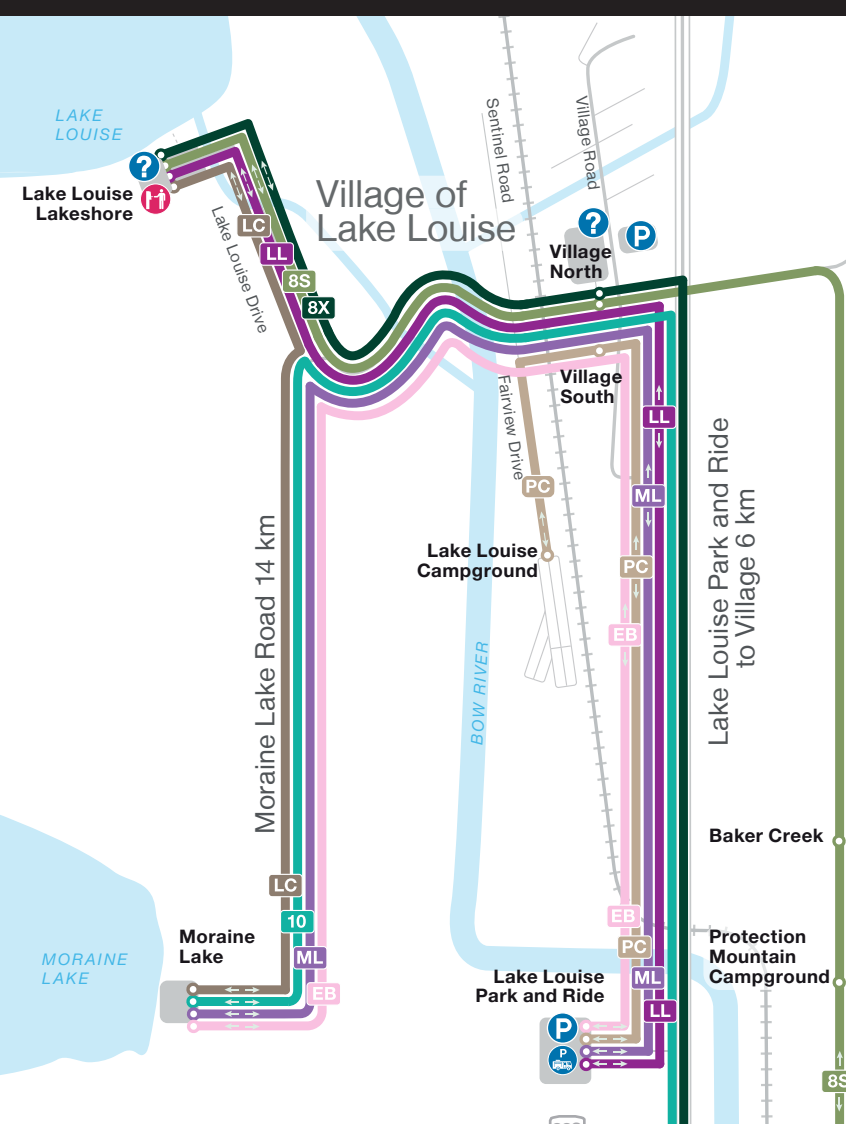


Banff National Park Public Transit



Reservations are required to ride Parks Canada shuttles to Lake Louise and Moraine Lake.
 Fare includes use of the Lake Connector shuttle between the lakes as well as return trip from either lake back to Park and Ride. Fare does not include reservation fee. Visit reservation.pc.gc.ca to book your spot and for more information.

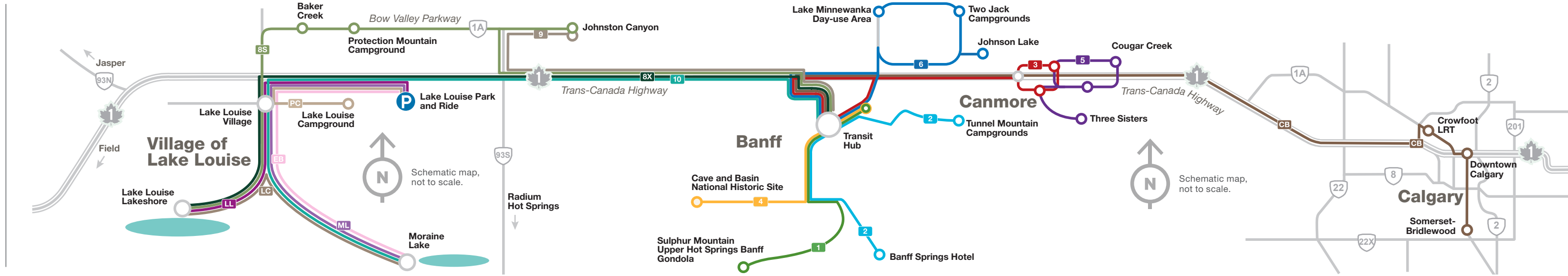
Our highest priority is the safety of visitors, residents and staff. In an effort to provide the safest and best experience possible, the following measures are in place for all transit and shuttle offers:

- Practice physical distancing at all loading and unloading areas.
- All vehicles have increased cleaning frequency throughout each day in accordance with guidance from provincial health authorities.

1 Route 1: Sulphur Mountain

Service between Banff Avenue hotels, Sulphur Mountain, the Banff Upper Hot Springs and the Banff Gondola.

Year-round

- Frequency between June 11 and September 19:
- every 40 minutes from 6:45 a.m. to 8:35 a.m.
 - every 20 minutes from 8:35 a.m. to 11:35 a.m.
 - every 15 minutes from 11:35 a.m. to 7:05 p.m.
 - every 20 minutes from 7:25 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

2 Route 2: Tunnel Mountain

Service between Tunnel Mountain campgrounds, downtown Banff, Bow Falls and the Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel.

Year-round

- Frequency between June 11 and September 19:
- every 60 minutes from 6:15 a.m. to 9:15 a.m.
 - every 30 minutes from 9:45 a.m. to 10:45 p.m.

3 Route 3: Canmore—Banff Regional

Service between the towns of Canmore and Banff.

Year-round

- Frequency on **weekdays** between May 21 and September 19:
- every 30 minutes from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
 - every 35 minutes from 9:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
 - every 60 minutes from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
 - last departure to Canmore from Banff at 10:00 p.m.
 - last departure to Banff from Canmore at 10:30 p.m.

Frequency on **weekends** between May 21 and September 19:

- every 60 minutes from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
- every 35 minutes from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- every 60 minutes from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- last departure to Canmore from Banff at 10:00 p.m.
- last departure to Banff from Canmore at 10:30 p.m.

4 Route 4: Cave and Basin

Service along Banff Avenue to the Banff Park Museum and the Cave and Basin national historic sites.

Summer Service

*Weekend and holiday service only between May 21 and June 13

- Frequency between May 21 and September 19:
- every 30 minutes from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

5 Route 5: Canmore Local

Service throughout Canmore.

Year-round

6 Route 6: Lake Minnewanka

Service between the town of Banff and Lake Minnewanka, Johnson Lake, as well as campgrounds and day-use areas on Lake Minnewanka Road.

Summer Service

- Frequency between May 21 and June 1:
- every 60 minutes from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Frequency between June 1 and September 19:
- every 60 minutes from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
 - every 30 minutes from 10:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

8X Route 8X: Lake Louise Express

Service from the town of Banff to Lake Louise lakeshore, along the Trans-Canada Highway with a stop at Lake Louise Village.

Year-round

- May 21 to September 19:
- Departures daily from 7:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

8S Route 8S: Lake Louise Scenic

Service from the town of Banff along the Trans-Canada Highway and the west section of the Bow Valley Parkway ending at the Lake Louise lakeshore. Other stops include Johnston Canyon and Protection Mountain campground.

Summer Service

- May 21 to September 19:
- Departures daily from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

9 Route 9: Johnston Canyon

Service from the town of Banff to Johnston Canyon.

Summer Service

- May 21 to September 19:
- Departures daily from 9:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m.

10 Route 10: Moraine Lake Express

Service from the town of Banff to Moraine Lake, along the Trans-Canada Highway.

Fall Service

- September 20 to October 11:
- Departures daily from 6:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

PC Park and Ride Connector Shuttle

Service between the Lake Louise Park and Ride, Samson Mall in the village of Lake Louise and Lake Louise Campground. Use this free shuttle to connect to your reserved Lake Louise lakeshore and Moraine Lake shuttles at the Park and Ride, and Roam Public Transit in the village of Lake Louise.

Summer Service

- Frequency between May 21 and October 11:
- every 30 minutes from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

This service is free. Reservations are not required between the Lake Louise Campground and Samson Mall in the Village of Lake Louise but you must have a valid reservation to connect to Lake Louise Lakeshore and Moraine Lake shuttles via the Lake Louise Park and Ride.

LM Moraine Lake Shuttle

Service between the Lake Louise Park and Ride and Moraine Lake. Reservations are required. Visit reservation.pc.gc.ca to book your spot.

Summer Service

- Frequency between June 1 and October 11:
- every 20 minutes from 8:10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

LL Lake Louise Lakeshore Shuttle

Service between the Lake Louise Park and Ride, and the Lake Louise lakeshore. Reservations are required. Visit reservation.pc.gc.ca to book your spot.

Summer Service

- Frequency between May 14 and October 11:
- every 20 minutes from 8:00 a.m. to 6:20 p.m.

EB Moraine Lake Early Bird Shuttle

Early morning drop-off service between the Lake Louise Park and Ride and Moraine Lake. Return to Lake Louise Park and Ride available on the Moraine Lake shuttle between 8:50 a.m. and 7:50 p.m.

Summer Service

- Frequency between June 21 and October 11:
- every 30 minutes from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

LC Lake Connector Shuttle

Service between the Lake Louise lakeshore and Moraine Lake for Parks Canada reservation holders only. Visit reservation.pc.gc.ca to book your spot on a Moraine Lake or Lake Louise Lakeshore shuttle. Expect delays: seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Summer Service

- Frequency between June 1 and October 11:
- every 15 minutes from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. from Lake Louise lakeshore to Moraine Lake
 - every 15 minutes from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. from Moraine Lake to Lake Louise lakeshore

This service operates on first-come, first-served basis for existing ticket holders. This is not available for anyone who did not reserve a shuttle departure from the Park and Ride. Visit parkscanada.ca/banff-transit for more information.

CB Calgary—Banff

Service between Somerset-Bridlewood, downtown Calgary, Crowfoot LRT station, and Banff. Additional stop in Canmore.

Summer Service

- May 21 – September 19
Friday evening, Saturday, Sunday and holiday Monday service

Reserve your ride on a Parks Canada shuttle

***New in 2021* Advanced shuttle reservations are required to visit the Lake Louise lakeshore and Moraine Lake.**

Parking at the Lake Louise lakeshore and Moraine Lake fills quickly. Visitors will be turned away when parking is full. For the best experience, take the Parks Canada shuttle.

Start your day at the Lake Louise Park and Ride loading area, arriving within your 1-hour reservation window. Conveniently visit both the Lake Louise lakeshore and Moraine Lake in the same day with proof of purchase. The round-trip fare includes use of the Lake Connector shuttle between the Lake Louise lakeshore and Moraine Lake.

Staying at the Lake Louise Campground or at a hotel in the village? Hop on the free Park and Ride Connector shuttle to the Park and Ride loading area with daily service from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. You can also leave your car in Banff and connect via Roam Public Transit.

Before you arrive:

- Book your Parks Canada shuttle reservation in advance.
- Print or take a screenshot of your booking confirmation. Internet access is unreliable at the Park and Ride loading area.
- Check safety requirements for riding shuttles.
- Come prepared with your own "COVID-kit" including hand sanitizer, masks for everyone in your group, water and snacks.
