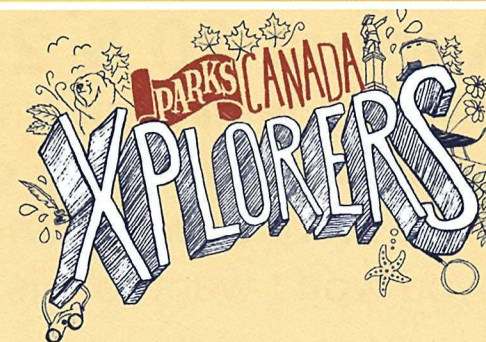
## Journey Through Time
