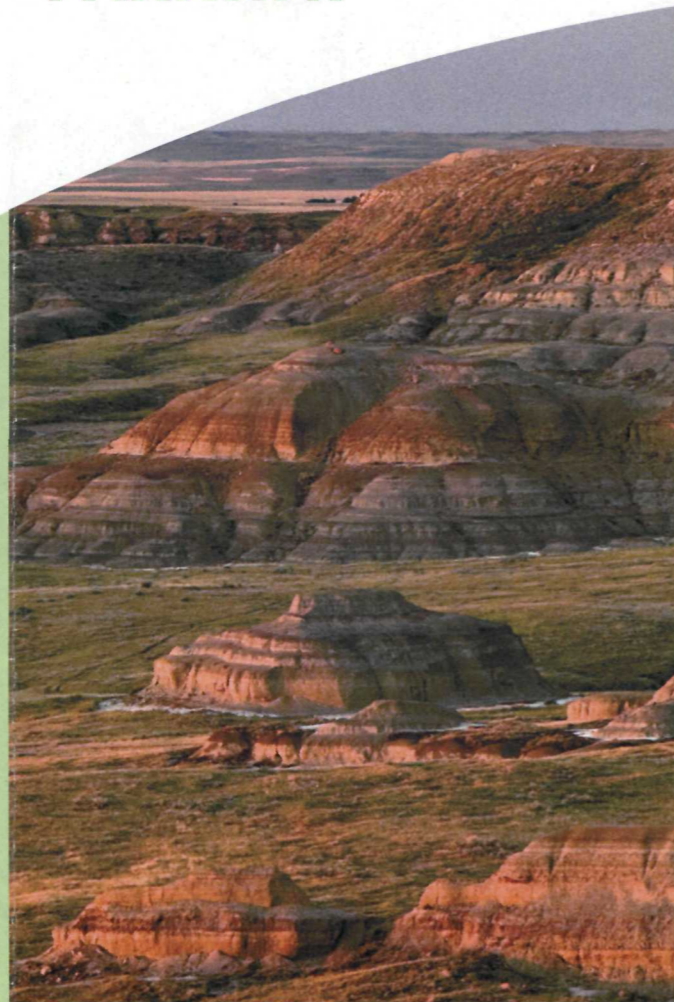
Grasslands National Park has decided to open the road prior to the completion of minor, final details so that we can offer this gift to our visitors, neighbours and stakeholders as early as possible.

BADLANDS PARKWAY



Welcome to the Badlands Parkway!

This scenic road has been designed and built with the utmost care for prairie conservation.

- Single-lane road with two-way traffic means half the disturbance on the landscape of a conventional, two lane road
- Narrow, grade-level road weaves away from quality habitat and sensitive cultural areas while guiding visitors to amazing scenery
- Road utilizes previously disturbed footprint where possible
- Road placed at park boundary edge minimizes fragmentation of habitat
- Durable base and pavement cap ensures minimal maintenance for years to come
- Construction crews and equipment performed 100% of their work within a very narrow corridor overlapping the road alignment

How to Enjoy the Road

- Single-lane road with two-way traffic. **Use pull-offs to yield to oncoming vehicles.**
 - (Please) Always keep your vehicle on the pavement. Do not drive on the prairie.
 - Park at designated viewpoint parking lots – return back along the same road travelled
 - At the parking lots, follow the pink flags and/or mowed paths to the primary viewing areas
 - Park trailers in the Rock Creek Campground or opposite the entrance. No RVs at this time.
 - **Do not travel down private neighbour access roads**
