Join us on the shores of the North Saskatchewan River for celebrations and a re-enactment of the epic 1967 Centennial cross-Canada Canoe Race. From lead-up activities in June to launch day on July 1st, follow the excitement as up to 26 teams of paddlers from across the country race downriver, voyageur-style, from Rocky Mountain House to the Pas, Manitoba.

June 21-26: Fur Trade Paddling School, for students from across Canada.

June 28: Voyageurs Parade, with race teams and their North Canoes.

June 29: Voyageur Whitewater Canoe Race.

June 30: Pancake breakfast with 1967 and 2017 race teams.

July 1: Opening ceremonies, and cheer teams on as they begin their 23-day race downriver!
