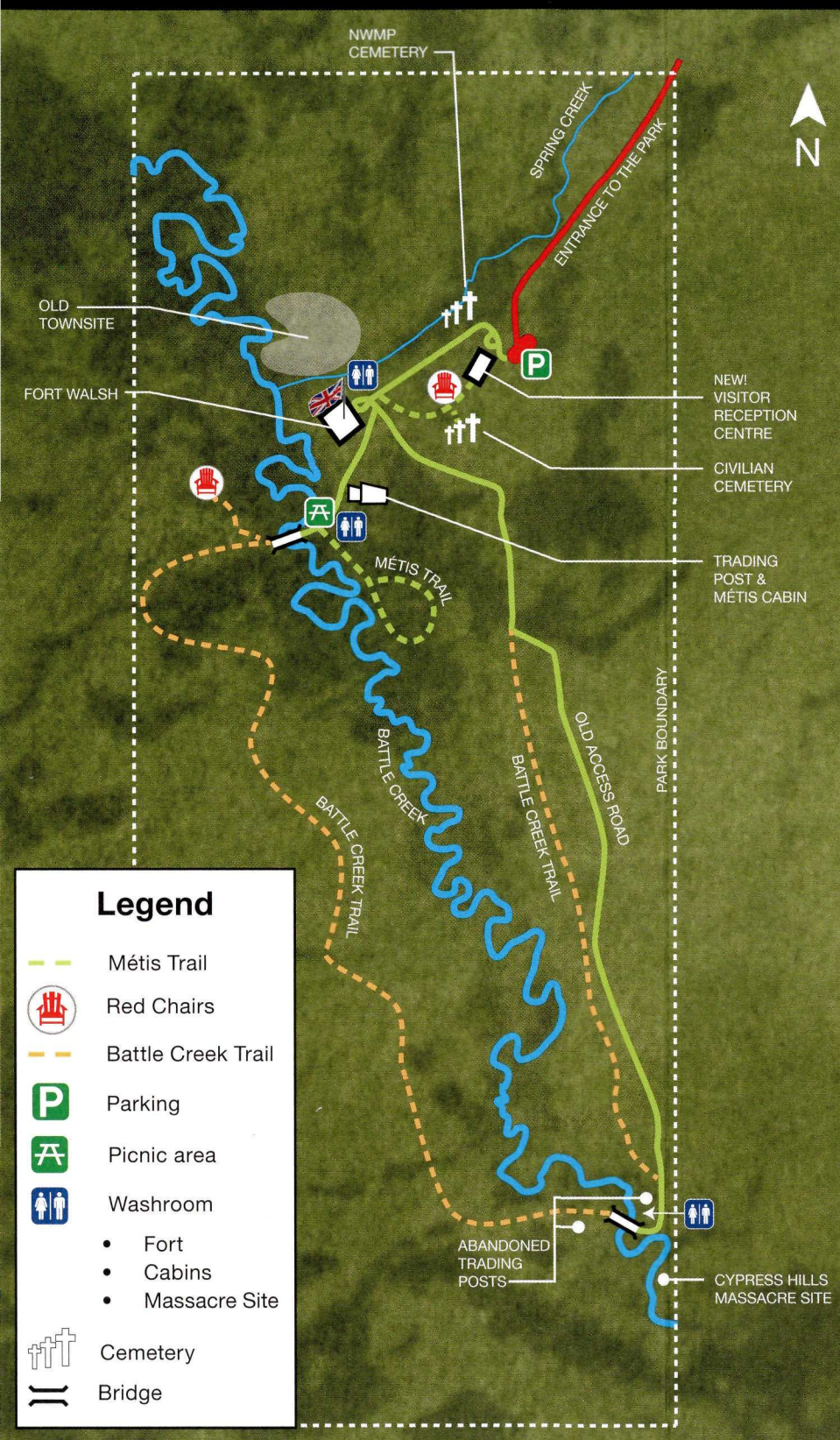

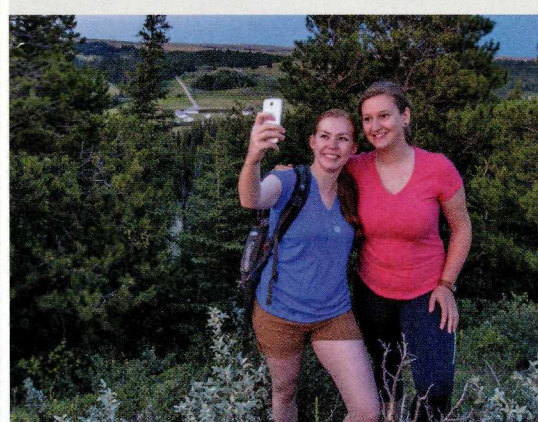

Backcountry Looking for more adventure? Hike the 6.5 km Battle Creek backcountry trail that explores the abandoned trading posts in the Battle Creek valley.

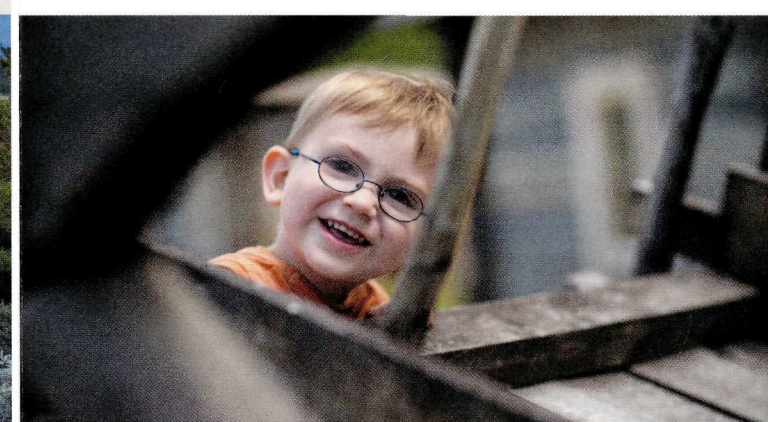


Fort Dailies

Cypress Hills Massacre Site Tour

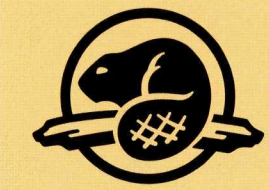
