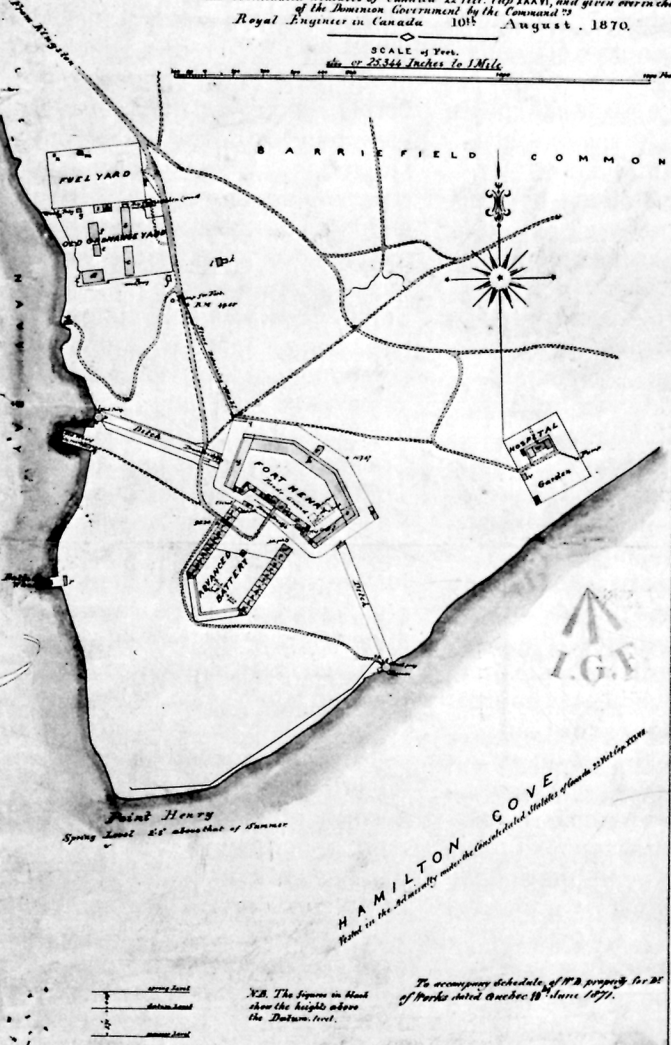

FORT HENRY, ADVANCED BATTERY, &c.

General Plan of Buildings and Works on the Fort Henry Reserve (Barrieffield Common) held by the Crown for defensive purposes since 1785-52, vested in the Secretary of State for War, under the Consolidated Statutes of Canada 22 Vic. (cap. XXXV), and given over to the Government by the Commandant of the Garrison in Canada 10th August 1870.
